JUBILEE OF MERCY MERCIFUL LIKE THE FATHER

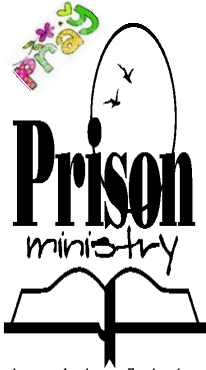
HOLY HOURS FOR OLV PARISH
