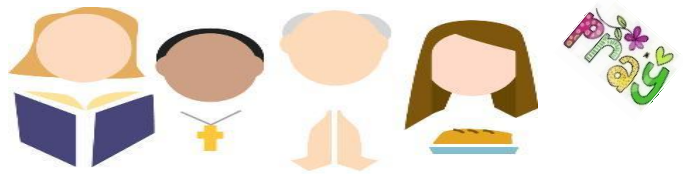

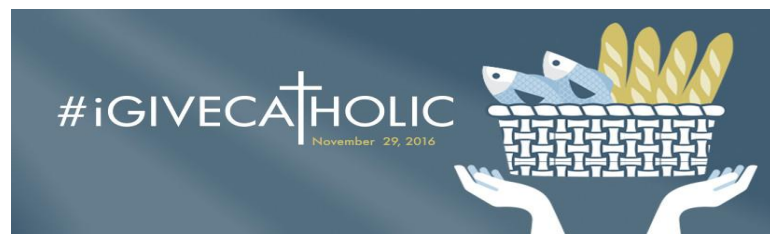

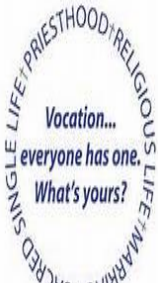
NATIONAL VOCATION AWARENESS WEEK
NOVEMBER 6TH – 12TH

This annual event is a special time for parishes in the U.S. to foster a culture of vocations for the priesthood, diaconate and consecrated life.

Pope Francis, in his homily at the final Mass of the 2016 World Youth Day in Krakow, encouraged the youth of the world to open their hearts to Jesus. “Don’t be afraid to say ‘yes’ to him with all your heart, to respond generously and to follow him!” said Pope Francis. “Don’t let your soul grow numb, but aim for the goal of a beautiful love which also demands sacrifice.”

National Vocations Awareness Week promotes vocation awareness and encourages young people to ask the question: “To what vocation in life is God calling me?” Parish and school communities across the nation are encouraged to include prayer and special activities that focus on vocation awareness.

“Prayer for vocations is the responsibility of the entire Church. Often times we think that vocations will come from somewhere else, and yet God invites us to consider that he is raising up vocations to priesthood, consecrated life, and the permanent diaconate from within our own communities, even our own families”.
