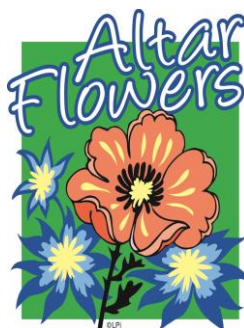

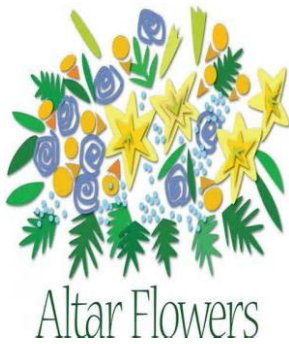

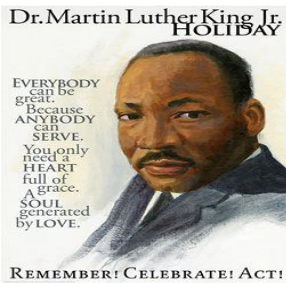

June's Prayer

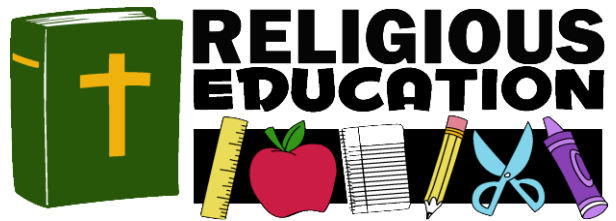
Dear Lord,
