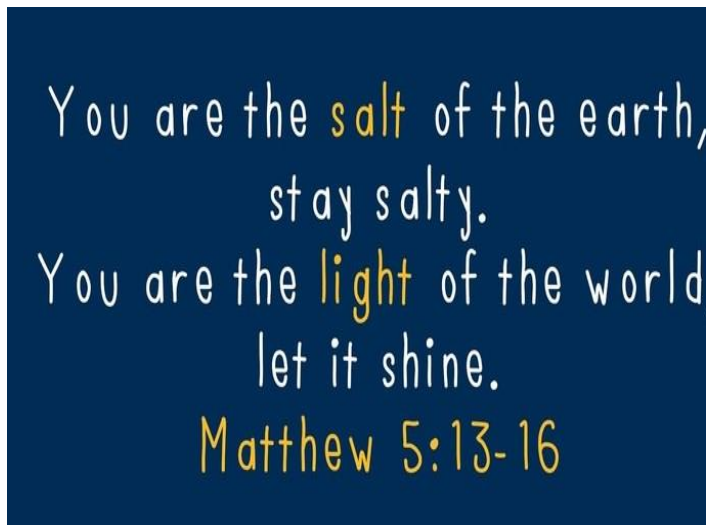

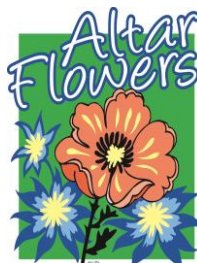

**Msgr. Louis Kihneman, III
 named Fourth
 Bishop of Biloxi**

The Episcopal Ordination and Installation of Bishop Louis Kihneman III as the Fourth Bishop of Biloxi will take place on Friday, February 17, at 2:30 p.m. in Nativity BVM Cathedral. Due to limited seating, the Mass will only be accessible by ticket overflow seating will be provided in the Sacred Heart Center, located directly behind the Cathedral. The Mass will also be televised live by WLOX and the eternal Word Network (EWTN). The Mass will be re-aired by EWTN on February 18th at 1:30 a.m.
